

Resident age¹:

- 19% are aged 0-15
- 25% are aged 25-44
- 10% are aged 65-74
- 7% are aged 75+

Resident ethnicity²:



- 2% from Asian backgrounds
- 1% from **Black** backgrounds
- 95% from White backgrounds



Household makeup²:

- 27% are single person households
- 31% have dependent children

Housing type³:



- **72%** of households **own** their home
 - o 29% own their semi-detached
 - o 29% own their detached house



- 18% live in a social rented home
- o 7% live in a socially rented semi
- 10% live in a private rented home
 - o 4% a private rented semi

- **27%** are physically **inactive**^{8,9} Less than 30 mins brisk walk a week
- 14% smoke10
- 10% drink alcohol at high/ very high levels¹⁰
