## Our people

11,800 - 20,200 people per ward<sup>1</sup>

Resident age varies between wards<sup>1</sup>:



- 16-30% are aged 0-15
- 21-31% are aged 25-44
- 6-13% are aged 65-74
- 3-16% are aged 75+



Resident ethnicity across Bolton2:

- 20% from Asian backgrounds
- 4% from **Black** backgrounds
- 72% from White backgrounds



Household makeup<sup>2</sup>:


- 31% are single person households
- 32% have dependent children






- 25-38% are physically inactive<sup>8,9</sup> Less than 30 mins brisk walk a week
